This event will be played at Rileys Club, Unit 10, Cremyll Road
Reading, Berkshire, RG1 8NQ.

On Sunday 19th December. Registration is at 11:30am, Competitions starts at noon.

New Format Details:-

- Entry £10 entry (paid in advance). All monies to the prize fund (no show, no refund, money stays in the prize pot).
- Maximum of 40 runners on the day.
- 8 groups of 5 with a seeded player in each group.
- Seeds per group and players all drawn on the day.
- Players play each other twice in the group (1 break each) and top 2 progress to round of 16.
- Each frame will be time kept and refereed as per county in the group stage. From round 16, up to and including the final will be 1 frame knock-out pool. In the knockout stage only, if your opponent breaks and clears you have the opportunity to return the favour. The third frame is decisive regardless.

Prizes

Winner £140 (this can increase if no shows)

Runner-up £60

Losing Semi-finalists £25x2

Group winners £15x8

Random draw to take place after group stage £30

Even if all 40 slots are taken, people can join the reserve list to replace no shows. Reserves that don't play will be refunded.

£5 single frame comps will take place after the last 16 matches.

This event isn't about the prize money. It's about giving players the chance to shine and play A or top B team players. Players get a guaranteed 8 frames as opposed to being knocked out 3-0 in a tournament format.

County is 1 frame pool, so why not play a tournament that way?
